Proposals for symposia could be submitted here

All interested IOP members and researchers in psychophysiology are invited to submit an application for a symposia to be presented at the 20th World Congress of Psychophysiology.

The application form requires the following information:

- 1. Title of Symposium
- 2. Name(s) of Proponent(s)
- 3. Brief paragraph describing the timeliness and importance of the topic, the desired format and presenter diversity, if applicable.
- 4. Name and affiliations for all presenters and proponents.
- 5. The title and, preferably, a brief summary of each presentation.

Scientific quality, novelty of the presentations, the general scientific interest of the topic and appropriateness for the meeting will be the primary selection criteria. Organizers should include presenters of diverse genders and nationalities and invite presenters from other institutions and laboratories. The deadline for symposia proposal is by **March 15**, **2020**. Acceptance or refusal will be notified by **March 30**, **2020**.

Each symposium should preferably be 90 minutes in duration, with four or five speakers (around 20-minute for each presentation) on interrelated topics.

The organizers of the accepted symposia will be kindly requested to ask each speaker to register and to submit his/her abstract (300-400 words) by **April 15, 2020**.

Each abstract should be formatted to include the following:

- **Title**. Please refrain from using all caps.
- Authors and Affiliations
- Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusions 400 Words Limit
- Figures (optional, max 2, less than 10 MB, acceptable Formats: JPG, PNG, GIF)
- **References** (optional, better if the abstract is unreferenced)

Any sponsorship, commercial interest or conflict of interest should be disclosed in the 'Additional Information' section.

All accepted symposia and abstracts will be published as a Special Issue of <u>International Journal of Psychophysiology</u>, which will be distributed to all registered participants at IOP2020 and will be electrically published on ScienceDirect (Elsevier) with individual digital object identifiers (DOIs). Please refer to the <u>International Journal of Psychophysiology guide for authors</u> for additional information on abstract formatting.

Important Note: Presenters in the symposia and workshops will not receive complimentary registration or honoraria. All symposia speakers are required to register for and attend the meeting. The due date of registration for presenters is **June 1, 2020.**
