

Posters

All accepted abstracts will be published as a Special Issue of International Journal of Psychophysiology, which will be distributed to all registered participants at IOP2021 and will be electronically published on ScienceDirect (Elsevier) with separate digital object identifiers (DOI). Unregistered authors will not have their abstract published. The due date of registration for presenters is **June 1, 2021**.

Each abstract should be formatted to include the following:

- **Title.** Please refrain from using all caps.
- **Authors and Affiliations**
- **Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusions** - 400 Words Limit
- **Figures** (optional, max 2, less than 10 MB, acceptable Formats: JPG, PNG, GIF)
- **References** (optional, better if the abstract is unreferenced)

Any sponsorship, commercial interest or conflict of interest should be disclosed in the 'Additional Information' section.

As tradition of past IOP congresses, there will be no oral paper sessions. Only poster presentations will be available for participants who could not organize or join a symposium. Nonetheless, depending on the number of symposia that will be proposed, **some proposers of posters may be selected by the Scientific Program Committee and invited to present their abstract at special oral sessions**, each of which consists of interrelated topics.

Members of the IOP2021 Scientific Program and Local Organizing Committees will review each abstract. The Committees expect to have high quality poster. Abstract acceptance will be strictly based on scientific content. Abstracts that are unethical, incomplete, or contain insufficient data will not be accepted. Experimental reports should include relevant data such as number of subjects studied or statistical information, as appropriate. When submitting abstracts for IOP2021 please consider whether or not multiple abstracts are necessary.

You are not required to register for the World Congress prior to submitting an abstract, however, if your abstract is selected for poster presentation, **the presenting author must register for the conference before June 1, 2021**. By May 1, the corresponding author will receive the decision about the acceptance, revision, or refusal of the abstract.
